

Are you registered to vote? Your Social Justice team encourages you to inform yourself on the candidates and issues, and let your voice be heard. The voter <u>registration</u> deadline is Oct. 5 in Ohio, so it's about time to check on your registration status and register if you haven't already done so. If you're not sure if your registration is current (maybe you moved?), you can use this link to check. Just enter your name and county: https://voterlookup.ohiosos.gov/voterlookup.aspx.

Vote! Great, now you're registered. You have options! At <u>www.waynecountyoh.gov/</u>, you can learn about your options.

- 1. Request an absentee ballot, which will be mailed to you and you mail it back. Absentee ballots must either be postmarked by the day before the election, or delivered in person to the Board of Elections by 7:30 p.m. on Election Day.
- 2. You can vote in-person absentee, by visiting the Board of Elections between Oct. 6 and Nov. 2 to cast your ballot, which hopefully will be less crowded.
- 3. In any case, you can also view a sample ballot for your exact location, so you will know exactly what's on the ballot and can cast your vote knowledgeably and quickly.
